The Problem

'The Extinction of All Life on Planet Earth' is now a definite probability, and it is not too distant from becoming an absolute certainty.

If it does happen, the singular cause will be the stupidity and the greed of humankind.

There is now a serious likelihood that, -by as soon as the year 2030, rapidly increasing global temperatures, and melting permafrost, ice-caps and glaciers, together with unprecedented atmospheric pollution and out of control grass and bush fires, will take our existence to the brink, and that by 2030 we will have reached 'the tipping point', and any hopes of preventing runaway global warming will have faded.

It will be then, that we will begin to reap the harvest of our indifference, and our inaction.

We humans are well aware of the problem, and of the cause.

We know full well what needs to be done,

but our systems of governance prevent even the smallest changes to our way of life, because our corrupt 'leaders' put their own self-interests before the interests of our planet, therefore things will simply carry-on as normal,

and we, -both the reader and this writer, -because of our inaction, are each to blame.

Today, immense areas of once arable land are now completely unproductive.

The layers of rich topsoils have now, because of poor farming practice, completely gone,
-washed away into streams and rivers, and thence into the seas,
leaving vast tracts of stony ground where even the weeds find it hard to survive.

By the year 2030 it is predicted that the global human population of planet Earth will have grown to exceed Ten Billion persons.

This represents a Twenty-Five percent increase on today's human population of Eight Billion.

An increase in the human population requires not only an identical increase in food production, but an increase in everything else, -in housing and factories, in shopping centres and in roads.

Our towns and cities will increase in size by a quarter as much again.

Even more land will be covered with concrete and bitumen. Even more forested areas will be cleared.

Each day, our atmosphere becomes more polluted and the 'blanket' layer becomes more effective.

With the anticipated increase in temperature, and the inevitable associated bushfires, together with the changes in climatic conditions of either drought or increased rainfall, still more of what is left of today's arable land will become unproductive.

This can only result in overproduction of the remaining land, with the expected consequences.

The multi-national corporations continue to demand increased production and profits, and their puppets, -our elected leaders, rush to obey.

We are fast running out of time to prevent the destruction of <u>all</u> life on this planet.

The Solution

Today, there remains 'only One way' to prevent the Total Extinction of All Life on this planet.

We have but 'One opportunity' to put things right before it becomes too late.

If we fail dear reader, you will suffer, -and so too will those for whom you care.

This 'One opportunity' demands an immediate reduction in the human population, -and immediate reduction, -and a drastic reduction.

Today, the human population on Planet Earth numbers **Eight Thousand Million**. Unless things quickly change, our population will soon reach **Ten Thousand Million** and the problems that we face today will, -at the very least, be amplified in proportion.

A twenty-five percent increase in the human population also means a twenty-five percent increase in pollution, -in food shortages, -and everything that is bad, -and the population will continue to grow, and so too will the problems, and the Total Extinction of All Life on this planet will have become Inevitable.

Planet Earth would function well with a limit of Two Thousand Million humans.

Two Thousand Million self-disciplined, well-mannered, healthy and educated people, and it is to such a number that we should agree, in order to avoid total extinction, and there is not much time left in which to achieve such a goal.

Unquestionably, the most important first step would be to round-up, -and to put away, the Human Rights Lawyers, the Preachers of God-Worship, and the other do-gooders, -together with those people who complain about the words that are written here, because 'they' represent the biggest impediment to the preservation of life on this planet.

The next most important step would be to round-up and to attend to the corrupt and incompetent anti-climate-change Politicians, Public Servants and the like, along with the greedy, corrupt Multi-National Corporation Executives to whom they grovel, and to deal with them all accordingly,

and every second delayed, -from this moment on, takes us one step closer to that 'lump of Lifeless Rock called Planet Earth'.

We can no longer afford the luxury of pretending that everything is going to be alright.

Failure to drastically reduce the human population

will result in the Total Extinction of All Life on Planet Earth,

and the animals, the birds, the insects, and the fishes have done nothing to deserve such a fate.

This now gives us the reason and the justification for attending to the situation.

It is at this point that a secondary problem arises.

Of all the creatures on this planet, human-beings are the only ones to be afflicted by that capricious and distorted emotion called 'sentimentality', and especially so in respect of the death of a loved human, or a pet animal, yet we care not about the deaths of the creatures that we murder without compassion, or of the humans that we slaughter on the screens, the battlefields and on the roads.

It is quite natural that the death of a dear friend, or relative, should evoke emotion. It is perfectly natural that a bereaved person should grieve over such a loss.

Other animals, upon the death of one of their kind, unquestionably display feelings of sadness and regret, and again, it is understandable that they should do,

but they do not dwell upon it for more than a brief period before getting on with their lives.

They walk away from the dead and leave the carcass for the eaters of carrion, -which is perfectly normal and natural, and is exactly how it should be.

We humans are nothing more, and nothing less, than animals.
With extinction in the offing, things need to change, -and quickly so.
We can no longer afford such 'sentimentality'.

We too must learn to walk away get on with our lives and, because it has now become so essential that we urgently reduce our population, it has become even more critical that we start to think and act like intelligent adults. We must abandon the practice of burying our dead, because,
-in addition to those persons who die in the normal course of events,
by deliberately reducing our population we will have corpses in overwhelming numbers,
and pollution-causing 'cremation' no longer remains an option.

The cleanest, the most-intelligent, and most effective way to dispose of dead persons would be to convert their corpses into something worthwhile, -something useful, -such as organic-fertiliser and pelagic-fish food, -the fertiliser being 'the blood and the bone', and the fish-food being 'the flesh, etc.'.

That would be 'recycling' in its purest possible form.

'That' is what 'clever people' would do, and we have the ability to do it in a clinical way, and it can be easily achieved in a simple, inexpensive and dignified manner.

It would be less polluting to each of the land, the oceans, and the atmosphere, and would instead help to replenish each one of them.

To do such a thing, -on the scale required, would be a major industrial enterprise. It would require the provision, -in each country, of many special-purpose machines, -each of which, is simple, cheap and easy to construct, -and each would be totally recyclable. Today, there are some Eight Thousand Million humans on this planet.

Two Thousand Million would be more than enough.

That leaves us with a surplus of some Six Thousand Million humans.

According to United Nations data, some 140,621,000 babies are presently born worldwide each year. Each year, natural attrition is said to account for 54,787,500 people worldwide, and this causes an annual increase to the human population of almost 86,000,000.

Eighty-Six Million extra people every year.

What follows will not be easy to read, but we are talking about 'Extinction', and the pain and the suffering that goes with 'that' will not be easy either.

It would be both immoral and unacceptable to allow people to keep producing children whilst other people are being asked to surrender their lives.

It would therefore become necessary to totally prohibit human reproduction until such time as the human population is reduced to Two Billion persons.

During any period of compulsory suspension in childbirth, any woman who fails to abort a pregnancy within nine weeks of becoming pregnant must be made to have her pregnancy aborted, -irrespective of the age of the foetus, and the woman must then be compulsorily sterilised or perhaps, even disposed of.

Not nice, but absolutely necessary.

The best way to start to reduce the human population would be to empty the Prisons, the Reform Homes, the Infirmaries, the Nursing Homes and the Lunatic Asylums, and to round-up the Anti-Social Thugs, the Criminal Gangs, the Drug Dealers, the Drug-Addicts, the Long-Term Disabled, together with Professional Sportspersons, their administrators, and other parasites, plus the useless, the helpless, and those persons who have passed their use-by-date, and to convert each one of them into a more useful and worthwhile state, -irrespective of their age, because not one of the above-mentioned persons serves any useful purpose, -and nor will they ever.

It is time for us humans to get our priorities into perspective.

Even if every person, -in the groups of people mentioned above, was disposed of, and if a total ban on human reproduction was implemented, it would still not solve the excess population problem.

At the absolute best, it might reduce the planet's population by some **Two Thousand Million**.

That would still leave us with some Four Thousand Million excess humans.

To divide a person's weight (in kilograms) by that person's height (in centimetres) would give a specific number which, **when multiplied by 10** becomes more realistic.

For a healthy, normal person, that number would be in the region of Four.

For obese people that number would be greater than Four

and the greater the obesity, the higher the number,

and therein lies a solution to the problem of the Four Thousand Million.

For those unfortunate persons whose mothers were too lazy to provide them with proper food, but who instead led them to frequent the premises of the Fast-Food Merchants and who taught them to stuff their faces with sweet tasting garbage, we must sympathise but, 'It is in their own hands to do something to remedy the situation'.

Exercise costs nothing. An apple and a banana is cheaper than a hot-dog and a bag of chips and it is certainly more nourishing and healthier, -and it doesn't make you fat.

In the days before god-worship began, humans were fit and healthy and, -to a man, their specific number would have been close to Four, -and that number is the number that we should again aim to achieve in the human race, -and there is an easy way to achieve it.

The level of a person's intelligence is also of critical importance. It is not difficult to measure a person's degree of intelligence, -or their degree of stupidity, -and this offers yet another solution to the problem of the Four Thousand Million.

Should we fail

to drastically reduce this planet's human population, -on a worldwide scale, then the developed countries will find themselves overwhelmingly swamped by endless waves of tens of millions of starving 'climate refugees' from failed and collapsing developing countries, and the only way to stop those people would be to bomb and sink the ships that carry them, or to machine-gun-them-down at land borders. If we were to construct a machine that was able, -in the space of one minute of time, to convert the corpse of one human into a more worthwhile state, then to convert **Six Thousand Million** corpses, -even with the machine operating non-stop, it would take **Eleven Thousand**, **Four Hundred and Fifteen years**, and by then planet Earth would have long, long, long ago been A Lump of Lifeless Rock.

Perhaps the reader can now understand the magnitude of the problem.

To do the job in the space of **Two years**, -allowing for stoppages and maintenance, we would need at least **Seven Thousand Five Hundred** machines, distributed around the planet.
